

activities to improve letter recognition


- Go on a letter scavenger hunt. Go through magazines or look while you are out and about. Look on boxes at the grocery store or on street signs.
- Make letters with play-doh
- Use the letter flashcards for quick recognition. There are multiple fonts, because not everything is written in "Times New Roman".
- Put the letter flashcards in alphabetical order
- Put the letter flashcards in a bag. Have your child pull a letter. If your child can name the letter, they may keep it. Otherwise, it needs to go back in the bag.
- Choose a letter for the day, and think of as many things as possible that start with that letter.
- Have your child write the alphabet on the "I know my alphabet chart".
